



Top 10 Worst Environmental Laws Passed by the Indiana State Legislature and Signed into Law on Gov. Holcomb's Watch

YEAR	LAW	IMPACT
2017	SB 309	Rolls back the benefits of net metering for those generating their own solar power
2017	SB 421	Removes the supervision of the Department of Environmental Management in regard to above-ground storage tanks
2018	HB 1227	Authorizes increased use of more powerful herbicides
2019	SB 472	Makes it easier for utilities to raise rates
2019	SB 535	Restricts ability of cities to control pollution on their outskirts
2019	SB 471	Increases risk of nonprofits being fined for protesting
2019	HB 1266	Reduces cities' ability to regulate water pollution and mitigate erosion resulting from construction
2019	HB 1470	Reduces regulatory oversight of utility companies
2020	SB 229	Anti-wetlands: removes permitting requirements for draining wetlands
2020	HB 1414	Makes the transition away from coal harder, with a regulatory roadblock. A hand-out to the coal industry.
